COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 322, L.D. 983, Bill, “An Act To Increase Efficiency in the Enforcement of Restitution and Bail Orders”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the 5th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "judgments" and inserting the following: 'unpaid restitution under Title 17-A, section 1326-A'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "185-A" and inserting the following: '5276-A'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "funds" and inserting the following: 'tax refunds'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 to 4.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment changes a reference to unpaid judgments to unpaid restitution and changes a cross-reference. The amendment strikes 3 sections of the bill that are unnecessary because prosecutorial districts are currently authorized to request that the State Tax Assessor offset an income tax refund to satisfy a liquidated debt.
