COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 325, L.D. 767, “An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Licensing of Certain Types of Establishments and Professions by the Department of Health and Human Services”

Amend the bill in section 3 in §2504 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the last line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "disclose" and inserting the following: 'determine the need for disclosure'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the Commissioner of Health and Human Services may not delegate the decision to disclose the identity of a complainant or the investigative record when disclosure is necessary to avoid imminent or serious harm.
