COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 337, L.D. 823, “An Act to Establish a Grant Program to Provide for Statewide and Equitable Access to Experiential Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Competition Programs”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §15312 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "is going" and inserting the following: 'intends'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §15312 in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and private schools"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that an organization that receives a competitive grant for statewide experiential science, technology, engineering and mathematics competition programs does not need to make the program available to students from private schools and that to receive a grant an organization must demonstrate that it intends to use the funds for a statewide experiential competition program.
