COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 433, L.D. 1064, “An Act to Increase the Minimum Teacher Salary”

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

General Purpose Aid for Local Schools 0308

Initiative: Provides funds to increase the minimum annual salary for certified teachers and career and technical education teachers from \$40,000 in fiscal year 2023-24 to \$42,500 in fiscal year 2024-25, \$45,000 in fiscal year 2025-26, \$47,500 in fiscal year 2026-27 and \$50,000 in fiscal year 2027-28.
