The agreement must require that the school employee successfully complete the Maine Criminal Justice Academy's training requirements to become a part-time law enforcement officer pursuant to Title 25, sections 2804-B and 2804-E. Upon completion of that training, a local law enforcement agency or sheriff may commission the school employee as a part-time law enforcement officer. A school employee commissioned as a part-time law enforcement officer pursuant to this subsection is subject to the policies and requirements of the local law enforcement agency or sheriff.'
