COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 529, L.D. 1299, “An Act to Prohibit the Unsecured Storage of Handguns in Motor Vehicles”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2017 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "42" the following: 'except that a motorcycle as defined in Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 38, a golf cart as defined in Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 25-A and an all-terrain vehicle as defined in Title 12, section 13001, subsection 3 are not considered motor vehicles for the purposes of this section'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2017 in subsection 4 in paragraph C in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2017 in subsection 4 in paragraph D in the last line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "duty." and inserting the following: 'duty; and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2017 in subsection 4 by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'E. A person who is a federally licensed firearms dealer pursuant to 18 United States Code, Section 923(a)(3) or a person shipping or delivering firearms to a federally licensed firearms dealer.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

## SUMMARY

This amendment adds exceptions to the prohibition against storing a handgun in an unoccupied motor vehicle, unless the handgun is stored out of plain view, for a federally licensed firearms dealer and a person shipping or delivering firearms to a federally licensed

1 firearms dealer. It also excludes motorcycles, golf carts and all-terrain vehicles from the  
2 definition of "motor vehicle" for the purposes of this provision.
