## SUMMARY

10 This amendment, which is the minority report, maintains existing law that prescribes 11 the number of beds at various Maine Veterans' Homes locations but strikes the provisions 12 that establish the number of beds that certain facilities may not exceed. The amendment 13 maintains the requirement that some facilities have a specific number of beds dedicated to 14 dementia patients. The bill proposes to remove any specific requirements for the number 15 of beds at any facility and for the location of the facilities, which have already been 16 constructed.
