COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 600, L.D. 1776, Bill, “An Act To Reduce the Membership of the Clean-up and Response Fund Review Board”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraphs E and F (page 1, lines 21 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

~~'E. One member representing marine fisheries interests appointed by the President of the Senate;~~

F. One member familiar with oil spill technology appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment retains as a member of the Clean-up and Response Fund Review Board the member familiar with oil spill technology, which the bill removes, and instead removes the member representing marine fisheries interests, which the bill retains.
