COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 641, L.D. 1592, Bill, “An Act To Amend the Maine Traveler Information Services Laws”

Amend the bill in section 4 in §1913-A in subsection 1 in paragraph L in the 2nd line (page 2, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "during the time period from May 1st to November 15th"

Amend the bill in section 4 in §1913-A in subsection 1 in paragraph L in the 3rd line (page 2, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "200" and inserting the following: '30'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes the restriction that a temporary sign may be placed within the public right-of-way only during the time period from May 1st to November 15th. It provides that a temporary sign may not be placed within the public right-of-way within 30 feet, instead of 200 feet as proposed in the bill, of another temporary sign bearing the same or substantially the same message.
