HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 963,  
L.D. 1317, Bill, “An Act Concerning Sex Offender Registry Information ”

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 9-A (page 1,  
lines 14 to 16 in amendment) and inserting the following:

**9-A. Registry information.** Registry information created, collected or maintained  
by the bureau, including, but not limited to, information relating to the identity of persons  
accessing the registry, is confidential, except the following are public records:

- A. Information provided to the public pursuant to subsection 9; and
- B. Applications and bureau decisions, including any documents made part of those  
decisions, pursuant to section 11202-A.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment specifies that any information maintained by the Department of  
Public Safety, Bureau of State Police, State Bureau of Identification relating to  
applications and decisions that are related to the process to seek relief from the duty to  
register are public records.
