COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 30, L.D. 18, “An Act to Allow the Department of Corrections to Increase Health Care Fees and Use the Proceeds from Those Fees to Offset the Costs of Client Medical Care Support Workers”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 5th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “\$25” and inserting the following: ‘\$15’

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “\$25” and inserting the following: ‘\$15’

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (8) in the first line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “\$15” and inserting the following: ‘~~\$15~~ \$30’

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, decreases the maximum medical and dental fees the department can charge from \$25 to \$15 and increases from \$15 to \$30 the maximum amount a client may have in the client's facility account to be eligible for free medical and dental services.
