This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, removes from the bill the provision that amends the antidegradation policy under the State's water classification program to provide that, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a person that meets a condition relating to any effect or potential effect on a species that is listed under the United States Endangered Species Act that is imposed or proposed to be imposed by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in granting a new license pursuant to 18 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 16, as amended, is considered to have met the State's water quality standards in the event that no equivalent state standard has been set. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
