SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 105, L.D. 164, “An Act to Fund the Lake Restoration and Protection Fund”

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §480-N by inserting after subsection 6 the following:

7. Funding sources. The fund may receive money from any source, public or private.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
