18 SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" and replaces the bill. The amendment directs the Department of Health and Human Services to develop a pilot program to reimburse under the MaineCare program for treatment of up to 25 MaineCare members diagnosed with personality disorder or other disorders associated with primary emotional dysregulation using a bundled rate. It also requires the department to submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters addressing the implementation and effectiveness of the pilot program by November 7, 2025. The amendment also allows the joint standing committee to submit legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature to continue or expand the pilot program.
