SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 917, L.D. 1421, “An Act to Provide Funds to the Maine Indian Education School District”

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF
School Finance and Operations Z078

Initiative: Provides one-time funds to the Maine Indian Education school district to develop and implement a Wabanaki-centered curriculum for Native American high school students. The Maine Indian Education school district will administer the pilot program in conjunction with state-approved high schools. The funds will be used for curriculum development, staff, transportation and support services.
