HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 932,  
L.D. 1436, “An Act to Provide Remedies for Survivors of Commercial Sexual  
Exploitation”

Amend the amendment in the 2nd section 1 in §2262-A in the first paragraph in the  
2nd line (page 1, line 21 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "17-A," the  
following: 'former'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that because of the repeal of the Maine Revised Statutes,  
Title 17-A, section 853-A in Public Law 2023, chapter 316, section 8, criminal history  
record information relating to a criminal conviction must be sealed for the former crime of  
engaging in prostitution.
