SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 13,
L.D. 4, “An Act to Adopt Eastern Standard Time Year-round”

Amend the amendment in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 13 in amendment)
by striking out the following: "at 2 a.m. on the 2nd Sunday of March 2026" and inserting
the following: 'when New Hampshire enacts and effectuates legislation establishing eastern
standard time as the standard time year-round for that state'

Amend the amendment by inserting before the 2nd instructional paragraph the
following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

**'Sec. 3. Notification of New Hampshire's observance of eastern standard
time year-round.** The Secretary of State shall notify the Secretary of the Senate, the
Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Revisor of Statutes when New Hampshire
enacts and effectuates legislation establishing eastern standard time as the standard time
for that state as provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 1, section 151, subsection 4.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that year-round eastern standard time for the State takes
effect when New Hampshire enacts and effectuates legislation establishing eastern standard
time as the standard time year-round for that state. It requires the Secretary of State to
notify the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the
Revisor of Statutes when New Hampshire enacts and effectuates such legislation.
