SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 237, L.D. 566, “An Act to Provide Funding for Sexual Assault Services”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

Sec. 1. Transfer to unappropriated surplus of General Fund. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before June 30, 2025, the State Controller shall transfer \$1,830,000 from the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Financial Institutions, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Purchased Social Services 0228

Initiative: Provides one-time funding for sexual assault services.
