SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 327,
L.D. 988, Bill, “An Act Regarding Possession of a Firearm on School Property”

Amend the amendment in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph D (page 1, lines
14 to 19 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'D. The prohibition on the possession of a firearm does not apply to a person who
possesses a firearm in a motor vehicle as long as the following conditions are met:

(1) The person is dropping off or picking up a student and remains inside the
motor vehicle; and

(2) The firearm is not loaded and is concealed either in the motor vehicle or on
the person's person.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement in Committee Amendment "A" that a
firearm in a motor vehicle of a person dropping off or picking up a student on school
property needs to be in a locked container or locked firearms rack. Instead, this
amendment requires the firearm to be concealed either in the motor vehicle or on the
person's person.
