SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 555, L.D. 899, “An Act to Authorize Vaccine Administration by Pharmacy Technicians and Reduce Vaccine Administration Training Requirements for Pharmacists”

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 2, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: "drugs and" and inserting the following: '~~drugs and~~'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 2, line 30 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "or" the following: 'may delegate the authority to administer drugs and vaccines'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "**drugs**" the following: 'or vaccines'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 2, line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "drugs or"

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the changes in the authority for a pharmacy technician apply only to the administration of vaccines.
