SENATE AMENDMENT " " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 759, L.D. 1099, Bill, "An Act To Establish a Fund for the Operations and Outreach Activities of the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Animal and Plant Disease and Insect Control Laboratory"

Amend the amendment in section 1 by inserting after §2432 the following:

§2433. Disposition of funds in the fund after April 30, 2017

Beginning May 1, 2017, notwithstanding section 2431, the commissioner shall administer the fund. Notwithstanding section 2432, the commissioner may distribute funds in the fund to the University of Maine Cooperative Extension for the purposes specified in section 2432, subsections 3 and 4 only.'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §4911 in subsection 6 in the first line (page 3, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and every April 1st thereafter"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §4911 in subsection 6 by striking out all of the blocked paragraph (page 3, lines 25 to 34 in amendment) and inserting the following:

The board shall review the fee imposed under this chapter between January 1, 2017 and April 1, 2017 and, following this review, shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over pest management matters that includes the quantity of registered products subject to the fee imposed under subsection 1 and the total amount of funds disbursed to Maine Revenue Services.'

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §4911 by inserting after subsection 7 the following:

8. Repeal. This chapter is repealed May 1, 2017.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting the following:

Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

6 This amendment repeals the pesticide container fee on May 1, 2017. The
7 Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry is given administrative control
8 over the Animal and Plant Disease and Insect Control Fund after that date and provided
9 the authority to disburse the funds to the University of Maine Cooperative Extension for
10 pest management and pesticide safety education and laboratory costs.
