19 20 21 22 23 24	This amendment removes the requirement added by Committee Amendment "A" that the rules be changed to state that payments to persons authorized to collect qualifying contributions may be made using only seed money contributions received by the candidate. This amendment also requires that the rules be changed to allow volunteers collecting qualifying contributions to be organized by a paid member of the candidate's staff, in addition to a volunteer or political party staff.
