15 16 17	Whereas, this legislation affects the outdoor cultivation of cannabis between the months of March and December and must take effect before the end of the 90-day period to address, as soon as possible, the current outdoor cultivation season; and
18 19 20 21	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
22	Amend the amendment by inserting after section 7 the following:
23 24	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
25 26	Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
27	SUMMARY
28 29 30	This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A." It adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause so that this legislation may take effect as soon as possible to address the current season for the outdoor cultivation of cannabis.
