HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1268,
L.D. 1897, “An Act Regarding Sun-grown Cultivation in the Medical Use and Adult Use
Cannabis Industries”

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this legislation affects the outdoor cultivation of cannabis between the
months of March and December and must take effect before the end of the 90-day period
to address, as soon as possible, the current outdoor cultivation season; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation
takes effect when approved.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A." It adds an emergency preamble
and emergency clause so that this legislation may take effect as soon as possible to address
the current season for the outdoor cultivation of cannabis.
