'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Improve Family Court Procedure and to Provide Drug Treatment Court Funding' '**

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 4 and 5 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 4. Transfer to Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services, Other Special Revenue Funds account.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before June 30, 2025, the State Controller shall transfer \$561,283 from the Department of Health and Human Services, Opioid Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services, Other Special Revenue Funds account.

**Sec. 5. Transfer to unappropriated surplus of General Fund.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before June 30, 2025, the State Controller shall transfer \$179,500 from the Department of Health and Human Services, Opioid Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund.

**Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

35 This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by changing the title and  
 36 requiring the State Controller to transfer \$561,283 from the Department of Health and  
 37 Human Services, Opioid Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Fund, Other Special  
 38 Revenue Funds account to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of  
 39 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services, Other Special Revenue Funds account on or  
 40 before June 30, 2025.

1           The amendment requires the State Controller to transfer \$179,500 from the Department  
2 of Health and Human Services, Opioid Use Disorder Prevention and Treatment Fund,  
3 Other Special Revenue Funds account to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund  
4 on or before June 30, 2025.

5           The amendment also removes the effective date provision and replaces the  
6 appropriations and allocations section.
