16 17 18	'B. A person who violates this section after previously having been adjudicated as violating this section within a 3-year period commits a traffic infraction for which a fine of \$150 must be adjudged.
19 20 21	For the purposes of this paragraph, an adjudication has occurred within a 3-year period if the date of the new conduct is within 3 years of the date of a docket entry of adjudication of a violation of this section.'
22	SUMMARY
23 24 25 26	This amendment reduces the penalty for a first offense of using a mobile telephone or handheld electronic device while operating a motor vehicle from a fine of \$250 to a fine of \$75. It also reduces the penalty for a subsequent violation within a 3-year period from a fine of \$500 and a license suspension to only a fine of \$150.
