HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “B” to S.P. 72, L.D. 236, Bill, “An Act To Protect the Privacy of Citizens from Domestic Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Use”

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4502 by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

2. Moratorium. Before July 1, 2015, a law enforcement agency may not use an unmanned aerial vehicle except as provided in section 4503, subsection 1.

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4502 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 3, line 8 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §4504 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2" and inserting the following: '3'

SUMMARY

This amendment imposes a moratorium until July 1, 2015 on the use of unmanned aerial vehicles by law enforcement agencies. The moratorium does not apply to specified emergency situations.
