SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 282, L.D. 598, “An Act to Require Minimum Pay for Reporting to Work”

Amend the bill in section 2 in §639-A in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "1" the following: 'or an employee of a public employer, as defined in section 626, who is covered by a collective bargaining agreement'

Amend the bill in section 2 in §639-A in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "'Employer" does not include a public employer as defined in section 626."

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the provision in the bill that excludes public employers from the definition of "employer." It adds an exception to the definition of "employee" for an employee of a public employer who is covered by a collective bargaining agreement.
