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1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment retains the emergency preamble and emergency clause in the bill. It
3	removes from Committee Amendment "A" the provisions that increase fees for watercraft
4	operating on the inland waters of the State and for lake and river protection stickers. It
5	increases from 60% to 80% the percentage of these fees dedicated to the Invasive Aquatic
6	Plant and Nuisance Species Fund in the Department of Environmental Protection and
7	reduces from 40% to 20% the percentage of these fees dedicated to the Lake and River
8	Protection Fund in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. It requires the
9	Commissioner of Environmental Protection to use at least 20% of the money in the
10	Invasive Aquatic Plant and Nuisance Species Fund for eradication activities. It allocates
11	funds from the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Carrying Account, General Fund account
12	within the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the Lake and River Protection
13	Fund in an amount equal to the reduction in funding to the Lake and River Protection
14	Fund caused by the reduction in the percentage of fees dedicated to the fund for the
15	current biennium.
