SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 576, L.D. 1458, “An Act to Increase Funding for the Maine School of Science and Mathematics”

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Transfer from Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection, Other Special Revenue Funds available balances to General Fund. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer \$500,000 from the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the General Fund unappropriated surplus no later than June 30, 2024.

Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF
General Purpose Aid for Local Schools 0308**

Initiative: Provides one-time funds to the Maine School of Science and Mathematics in fiscal year 2023-24 and fiscal year 2024-25 only.
