13 **SUMMARY**

14 This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to change:

15 1. From December 31, 2022 to March 1, 2023 the date by which the Department of
16 Health and Human Services must provide an alternative, updated method for rebasing
17 federally qualified health center prospective payment system rates;

18 2. From December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2023 the date after which the department
19 may change the base year used for rebasing federally qualified health center prospective
20 payment system rates;

21 3. From December 31, 2022 to February 1, 2023 the date by which the department must
22 issue final rate letters implementing the reimbursement option chosen by each federally
23 qualified health center; and

24 4. From July 1, 2022 to March 1, 2023 the date on which the reimbursement option
25 chosen by each federally qualified health center is effective.

26 The amendment also strikes and replaces the appropriations and allocations section.
