1 2	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and			
3 4	Whereas, state funding for the University of Maine System has remained relatively flat for a number of years; and			
5 6	Whereas, this flat funding has led to the proposal to eliminate certain university programs and faculty; and			
7 8	Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect immediately to provide sufficient funding to avoid irreparable harm to the University of Maine System; and			
9 10 11 12	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,			
13	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
