## An Act To Authorize Snowmobile Registration Reciprocity with the Provinces of New Brunswick and Quebec

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13104, sub-§16, ¶¶A and B,</b> as enacted by PL 2013, c. 588, Pt. E, §6 and affected by §7, are amended to read:
4 5	A. The nonresident's snowmobile has a valid registration from another state or from the Canadian provinces of New Brunswick or Quebec; and
6 7 8	B. The nonresident's state <u>or province</u> of residency allows a snowmobile registered in Maine to be operated in that state <u>or province</u> for a period of time of at least 3 consecutive days without being registered in that state <u>or province</u> .
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill extends the reciprocity provision in current law allowing for operation in the State of snowmobiles registered in other states to the Canadian provinces of New Brunswick and Quebec.
