1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6	This bill proposes to enact measures designed to stabilize the price of lobster bait These measures may include, but are not limited to:
7	1. Authorizing an increase in the number of people that may fish for bait;
8	2. Amending the limits on specific species of bait; and
9	3. Amending restrictions on the types of species that may be used as bait.
