2 **CONCEPT DRAFT** 3 **SUMMARY** 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 5 The purpose of this bill is to help ensure that patients with complex medical conditions who are in hospitals are placed in more appropriate nonhospital settings. 6 The bill proposes to fund the ongoing costs associated with beds in nonhospital 8 settings for: 9 1. Patients with severe brain injuries; 10 2. Bariatric patients; 11 3. Patients who are dependent on a ventilator for the long-term; 12 4. Young adult patients with substance abuse issues who receive extended intravenous therapy due to infections; 13 5. Young adult patients with spinal cord injuries; 14 6. Young adult patients who have had strokes; 15 16 7. Homeless patients who need preoperative care such as feeding tubes; and 17 8. Patients who are violent and have been previously discharged from a health care 18 facility due to violence.
