1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12656, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:
4 5	B. Except as otherwise provided, use any grapnel, spear, spear gun speargun, trawl, weir, gaff, seine, gill net, trap or set lines for fishing.
6 7	(1) A person may take suckers, eels, alewives and yellow perch in accordance with section 12506.
8 9	(2) A person may take baitfish with a baitfish trap, as defined in section 10001 , subsection 7.
10	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12656, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
11	1-A. Exceptions. Notwithstanding subsection 1, paragraph B, a person may:
12	A. Take suckers, eels, alewives and yellow perch in accordance with section 12506;
13	B. Take baitfish with a baitfish trap, as defined in section 10001, subsection 7; and
14	C. Use a spear or speargun to fish for northern pike in Sebago Lake.
