An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Temporary Sign Usage

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶L,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 403, §4, is amended to read:
 - L. Temporary signs placed within the public right-of-way for a maximum of $6\,\underline{12}$ weeks per calendar year. A temporary sign may not be placed within 30 feet of another temporary sign bearing the same or substantially the same message. A temporary sign may not exceed 4 feet by 8 feet in size. A sign under this paragraph must be labeled with include or be marked with the name and address of the individual, entity or organization that placed the sign within the public right-of-way and the designated time period date the sign will be maintained was erected within the public right-of-way.
