SUMMARY

28 This amendment is the majority report of the committee and requires the use of preapproved subcontractors for certain components of work included in bids awarded to 29 general contractors for the construction, major alteration or repair of school buildings 30 over \$250,000. It also increases the threshold proposed in the bill for the use of 31 preapproved subcontractors from \$100,000 to \$250,000 for capital improvement 32 contracts subject to competitive bidding that included the use of subcontractors in its bid. 33 It also removes the list of components of capital improvement projects in the bill and 34 instead makes reference to a list of components to be maintained by the Department of 35 Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services. The amendment also 36 37 adds an appropriations and allocations section.
