1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§95 is enacted to read:
3 4	95. Sales tax holiday. Sales of tangible personal property during the month of January, excluding individual items of property the price of which exceeds \$1,000.
5	SUMMARY
6 7	This bill provides a sales tax holiday during the month of January for items of tangible personal property with a price of \$1,000 or less.
