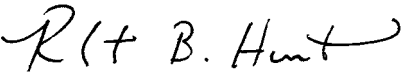

5 pursuant to section 7104-B; ~~or~~

6 **Sec. 2. 35-A MRSA §117, sub-§3, ¶B**, as amended by PL 2011, c. 27, §2, is further
7 amended by amending subparagraph (5) to read:

8 (5) To supplement any other program or fund that the commission determines
9 would benefit customers affected or potentially affected by the violation; or

10 **Sec. 3. 35-A MRSA §117, sub-§3, ¶B**, as amended by PL 2011, c. 27, §2, is further
11 amended by enacting a new subparagraph (6) to read:

12 (6) To supplement available funding sources for intervenor funding pursuant to
13 section 1310-A, subsection 2.

14 **Sec. 4. 35-A MRSA §1310-A, sub-§2, ¶B**, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 736, §2, is
15 amended to read:

16 B. Provide compensation to the intervenor from the Public Utilities Commission
17 Regulatory Fund established pursuant to section 116, administrative penalties and
18 filing fees, subject to the commission's determination that funds are available for that
19 purpose.

21 This bill allows administrative penalties collected by the Public Utilities Commission
22 to be used for intervenor funding.
