1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §3861 is enacted to read:
3	§3861. Trespass by unmanned aerial vehicle; civil violation
4 5	1. Violation. A person may not operate an unmanned aerial vehicle over the land of another without written permission from the landowner.
6 7	2. Penalty. A person who violates subsection 1 commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$500 must be adjudged.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill makes operating an unmanned aerial vehicle over the land of another without written permission of the landowner a civil trespass punishable by a fine of not less than \$500.
