Be it enacted by the reopie of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4320-A, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
4. Annual wellness visit. A carrier offering a health plan with an effective date of January 1, 2024 or after may not require a provider to submit a claim, use a billing code or otherwise submit documentation relating to billing for an annual wellness visit during which a provider does not render any health care services to an enrollee.
SUMMARY
For a health plan with an effective date on or after January 1, 2024, this bill prohibits a health insurance carrier from requiring a provider to submit a claim, use a billing code or otherwise submit documentation relating to billing for an annual wellness visit during which the provider does not render any health care services to an enrollee.
