SUMMARY 32 33 This amendment, which replaces the bill with a resolve, directs the Department of 34 Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to establish an interagency working group to 35 develop recommendations, including suggested legislation, to define and regulate

The department is required to consult with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and other state and federal agencies as needed and seek input from a statewide municipal association and a statewide harbor masters association that represents Maine harbor masters. The department is required to submit a report with findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters no later than January 1, 2024. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters is authorized to submit a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature based on the subject matter of the report.
