Department of Transportation study. **Resolved:** That the 2 Department of Transportation shall convene a work group of interested parties and persons with expertise in traffic light systems and technology to study requiring new 3 traffic lights to accommodate color-blind drivers. The study must include an analysis of 4 the effectiveness of the available technology and its costs. The department shall submit a 5 report on its study, including any suggested legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee 6 on Transportation by December 4, 2019. The joint standing committee may report out a 7 bill related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 129th Legislature. 8

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to convene a work group of 10 11 interested parties and persons with expertise in traffic light systems and technology to study requiring new traffic lights to accommodate color-blind drivers. It requires the 12 study to include an analysis of the effectiveness of the available technology and its costs. 13 The department is directed to submit a report on its study, including any suggested 14 legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation by December 4, 2019. 15 The joint standing committee is authorized to report out a bill related to the report to the 16 Second Regular Session of the 129th Legislature. 17
