Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to issue request for proposals for quality child care services. Resolved: That, no later than January 1, 2024, the Department of Health and Human Services shall issue a request for proposals to establish a quality child care program for children from birth to 3 years of age in Kennebec County in order to alleviate the long waiting lists for child care services. The child care program must focus on play, movement, nutrition, social engagement and exploration with toys and materials and provide education for parents on their children's development.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
