1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to establish a means of determining the long-term goal of fisheries
6	management in the State, including developing a method of outcome testing proposed
7	legislation and rules. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction
8	over marine resources matters would use the outcome testing to evaluate the effect of the
9	proposed legislation or rules on fisheries management and include the Department of
10	Marine Resources advisory committees and lobster management policy councils in the
11	decision-making process.
12	The bill would require the periodic review of the fisheries management laws and
13	goals in order to ensure that they remain pertinent and applicable.
