1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§96 is enacted to read:
3 4	<u>96. American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars.</u> Sales to posts of the American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars.
5	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2015.

7 8	This bill provides an exemption from the sales and use tax for sales made to posts of the American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars.
