- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4722-A, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

3 5. Certificates of content area proficiency. A school administrative unit may 4 award a certificate of content area proficiency to a student who has demonstrated proficiency in each content area of the system of learning results established under 5 section 6209. A certificate of content area proficiency may be included in the student's 6 permanent academic transcript, and a student may use a certificate of content area 7 proficiency as an official credential of academic achievement for the purposes of 8 9 employment and postsecondary education. A school administrative unit may report its 10 issuance of certificates of content area proficiency to the department, and the department may collect and aggregate these data as evidence of intermediate progress towards high 11 school graduation goals. 12
