1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15688, sub-§3-A, ¶B,</b> as amended by PL 2007, c. 240, Pt XXXX, §30, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7	B. Except as provided in paragraph B 1, for For a school administrative district community school district or regional school unit composed of more than one municipality, each municipality's contribution to the total cost of education is the lesser of:
8	(1) The municipality's total cost as described in subsection 2; and
9 10	(2) The total of the full-value education mill rate calculated in section 15671-A subsection 2 multiplied by the property fiscal capacity of the municipality-; and
11 12	(3) The EPS per-pupil rate multiplied by the municipality's most recent calendar year average pupil count.
13	SUMMARY
14 15 16 17	In the case of a school administrative district, community school district or regional school unit composed of more than one municipality, this bill limits the municipal contribution to the total cost of education to the essential programs and services, EPS per-pupil rate multiplied by the municipality's most recent calendar year average pupil count.
