1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRS §652, sub-§13**, as amended by PL 2009, c. 435, §10, is further
3 amended to read:

4 **13. ~~Certain automobiles,~~ Automobiles and commercial vehicles and vehicles more
5 than 25 years old. Automobiles and all over-the-road commercial vehicles ~~with a model~~
6 ~~year prior to 1995, except when the Secretary of State determines it is in the best interest~~
7 ~~of the State and the applicant to issue a title to a vehicle with a model year prior to 1995~~
8 more than 25 years old;**

9 **SUMMARY**

10 Current law provides that vehicles with a model year prior to 1995 are not required to
11 have a certificate of title. This bill includes under this exemption all vehicles more than 25
12 years old, which is the same standard as antique automobiles.
